Updates from the Clinical Team.

This week has been busy one! We've had two new groups start, which the children have been enjoying.

Some of our children are attending a weekly session in the therapy room which explores different sensory experiences as well as looking at developing the children's communication and interaction skills. This week, we rolled balls in paint across the floor; this involved making choices between the balls and colours, using our gross motor skills to roll the ball and exploring different textures with our fingers (... or for some children, our feet!)



Some children also attended our new food exploration group. The aim of this group is to support children to explore different textures through play, whilst also offering opportunity to try new food sensations in a safe environment.
